

PARADISE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORK SESSION MINUTES
JULY 6, 2022
5:00 P.M.

Public Comment Statement

Gonze stated that due to administrative error, the Work Session agenda was not posted within the twenty-four hour time period as required by the Sunshine Law. The agenda was posted at approximately 11:00 a.m. on July 6, 2022 for a Work Session to begin at 5:00 p.m. The Board of Supervisors will strictly adhere to the agenda. No new items will be added to the agenda or to the meeting.

SPECIAL NOTE

To meet the requirements established by the Office of Open Records for virtual meetings, this meeting is being audio and video recorded via Zoom from the initial announcement of the meeting until its end. The meeting Zoom link was posted on the Township's website where the public may join the Zoom meeting, interact, and ask questions in real time.

Timber Harvest on Mount Airy Land – Members of the Paradise Township Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) were present to discuss the timber harvests that were conducted on Mount Airy's properties and possible prohibitions to such activity set forth in the Conservation Easement and Ordinance. There was a lengthy discussion regarding the Conservation Easement and whether the parameters of the easement were violated. Mr. McGlynn stated that there are two additional timber harvests scheduled through 2024 that may need to be put on hold until the requirements of the Conservation Easement can be determined and followed. The Board discussed possible actions going forward regarding the timber harvesting on Mount Airy property.
