FAQs

- Short-term Rentals are **PROHIBITED** in Residential Zoning Districts of the township. They are only permitted in B1, and B2 Districts and you must obtain a license and permit through the township in order to have a STR.
- Paradise Township is a "Zoned Community", which means you are required to obtain zoning, building, and sewage permits. If you are unsure if a project requires a permit, please call and ask.

LETTER FROM CONCERNED RESIDENTS

Dear Paradise Valley Neighbor,

Recently a gentle, friendly guy in his 20s was run over and killed in our community.

He was hit sitting in his lawn chair above Paradise Valley Road, waving at cars going by, as he often did.

Maybe he waved at you once or twice. Maybe you waved back.

He's not the only one. Speeding through Paradise Valley is causing fatalities, near misses, and crashes. From the railroad tunnel to the bridge on the way to Mount Pocono, drivers scoff at the hills, curves, poor sight-lines, and 45-mile speed limit.

The State Police have promised more enforcement and patrols. But they're short-handed and stretched thin.

Will you please help?


Keep it to 45. Stay off your phone. Give neighbors who live along 191/940/Paradise Valley Road a break as they turn into and leave their driveways.

Outdoor Safety

- If you can hear thunder, you are within striking distance of lightning. Look for shelter inside a home, large building, or a hard-topped vehicle right away.
- Do not go under trees for shelter. There is no place outside that is safe during a thunderstorm.
- Wait at least 30 minutes after hearing the last clap of thunder before leaving your shelter.
-))) Stay away from windows and doors. Stay off porches.
- There is no safe place outside. Places with only a roof on sports fields, golf courses, and picnic areas are not safe during a lightning storm. Small sheds should not be used.
- If a person is struck by lightning, call 9-1-1. Get medical help right away.

Indoor Safety

Turn off computers. Stay off corded phones, computers, and other things that put you in direct contact with electricity or plumbing. You can use a cell or cordless phone.

Do not wash your hands, bathe, shower, do laundry, or wash dishes.


