## [HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Paradise on May 6, 2008]

- § 100-1. The Second Class Township Code 53 P.S. 66915(c) is incorporated herein as if more fully set forth at length herein.
- § 100-2. The Board of Supervisors hereby allow the Board of Education of the Pocono Mountain School District (Board of Directors) to assume the hiring and oversight of Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards within the Township of Paradise.
- § 100-3. The Pennsylvania State Police and the Pocono Mountain School District will work together to ensure that any necessary training of and assistance to the Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards hired by the Pocono Mountain School District while on duty is provided. The Pocono Mountain School District recognizes Paradise Township has no police department to provide any training services for Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards.
- § 100-4. Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards shall be authorized only in the management of traffic and pedestrians in and around the areas of the Township identified by either the Pennsylvania State Police and/or the School District Superintendent and/or their designees.
- § 100-5. The Board of Education of the Pocono Mountain School District (School Directors) shall have the authority to fix and establish compensation of any and all Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards within Paradise Township, and any and all persons designated as Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards shall be employees of the School District and shall come under the provisions of the Code as set forth in 53 P.S. 66915(c). Upon approval by the Board of Supervisors of this Ordinance, the School District shall assume the payment of compensation including the fixing of such compensation, if any, for the Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards. Auxiliary policemen appointed as prescribed by general law may be hired by the School District to serve as Traffic Control Officers/Crossing Guards.
